RESOLUTION REGARDING ILLICIT DISCHARGE PREVENTION

WHEREAS, the Southeast Wisconsin Professional Baseball Park District (the “District”) is permitted by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to discharge storm water from all portions of the municipal separate storm water system owned or operated by the District under Wisconsin Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (WPDES) Permit No. WI-S049921;

WHEREAS, the District has implemented a written program to detect, remove, and eliminate illicit discharges and connections to the municipal separate storm sewer system;


WHEREAS, as part of the permit and written program, the District is required to pass an ordinance, order or similar means to prevent and eliminate illicit discharge and connections to the municipal separate storm sewer system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the District has developed an Illicit Discharge Detection & Elimination (IDDE) Program Manual which identifies all the steps and measures the District will take to detect, remove and eliminate illicit connections and discharges to the District’s separate storm water sewer system.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the District prohibits illicit discharges and connections to the municipal separate storm sewer system owned or operated by the District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the District is committed to putting forward the best effort possible to protect the Menomonee River and Wood Creek from illicit discharges and connections to ensure the health of our vital natural resources.
